CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

What is the difference between the *lost* and the *unreached* in our world today?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1. How do we see Jesus' heart for the nations through His command to us in Acts 1:8?
- 2. What is the significance of Acts 2:5, 9-11 considering what happened on the Day of Pentecost (2:1-4)?
- 3. Is it possible to have a "spirit of Jonah" (looking down on other cultures when it comes to them receiving God's blessing) even today?
- 4. What do you suppose the Jewish believers thought about this outpouring of the Spirit on other cultures (see Acts 10:45)?
- 5. How can we apply Paul's words in Romans 15:20 to our approach to reaching unreached people groups today?

PRAY

- 1. Pray for a heart of compassion for the unreached people groups of today. Pray for laborers and for the gospel to take hold in those communities.
- 2. Identify and pray for those in your life who do not know Jesus. Pray for their salvation and an opportunity to share the gospel with them.
