

SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: Acts 2:37-47
SERMON DATE: 11.19.23

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

Discuss a time when someone was generous to you. Maybe they gave you time, shared their talent, or helped financially. How did their generosity make you feel?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1) In verse 38, Peter calls people to repent and be baptized. What role does repentance play in the life of a believer?
- 2) Verses 44-45 describe the believers sharing everything they had. How might this generosity challenge our understanding of giving and community?
- 3) Look back at the significance of breaking bread together in verse 46. How do meals together contribute to a sense of unity among believers?
- 4) Verse 47 tells us that the early church had favor with all the people. What key elements of their community life contributed to this positive perception from outsiders? What are ways we can apply those elements today?

PRAY

- 1) Pray for favor and a positive perception from those outside the church, just like we saw in verse 47, that your life group and our church could be an example of God's love and grace.
- 2) Pray for a spirit of unity with our church and the Church. Pray that believers willingly share their lives and resources for the well-being of one another.
