PASSAGE: ACTS 4: 23-31
SERMON DATE: 02.04.24

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

How do you respond to challenges or opposition in your life? Is it difficult to remain bold in the face of adversity at work or with friends and family?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1) What did Peter and John do after being released from custody? How did they approach their situation?
- 2) How did the early believers respond to the threats and persecution they faced? How might you respond?
- 3) In verses 24-30, the believers pray. How does the prayer demonstrate their reliance on God and His sovereignty?
- 4) As we read this passage, how can we apply unity, prayer, and boldness to our lives?

PRAY

- 1) Pray for the strengthening of your faith and other believers, that we may trust God's power and provision, even in times of difficulty.
- 2) Pray for courage and boldness to speak the truth of the Gospel, even with threats of persecution.
- 3) Pray for the Gospel to transform lives at Austin Ridge and our community, as seen in the early church.
