PASSAGE: ACTS 4:32-5:11

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

When you were growing up, did you ever get caught in a lie? What was the reaction from others when everything came to the surface?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1) In Acts 4:32-37, how would you describe the community of believers? What can we learn from them regarding community and generosity?
- 2) What motivated Ananias and Sapphira to lie about the proceeds of their property sale? What consequences did they face for their deceit?
- 3) As we read about the impact of deceit and hypocrisy within this community of believers, how can dishonesty or a lack of transparency hinder the effectiveness of our witness and unity as the body of Christ?
- 4) How does the story of Ananias and Sapphira illustrate God's desire for genuine repentance and restoration?

PRAY

- 1) Pray for a spirit of generosity and unity within our Church.
- 2) Pray that we may have a healthy fear of God, that we would understand the seriousness of our sin and its consequences, and that it may lead us to walk in obedience before Him.
- 3) Ask God to help us maintain a credible witness to our community, understanding that we reflect the character of Jesus Christ and can impact others for His kingdom.
