SERMON: ACTS 7: 1-16

## CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

What was a circumstance in your life that made it difficult to trust God's sovereignty, but you ultimately felt His faithfulness?

## GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the passage?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

## GO

- 1) Why do you think Stephen recounts Israel's history to the Sanhedrin? What was the significance of their history he chose to highlight?
- 2) Discuss the significance of Joseph's story. What are the parallels between his story and the broader theme of God's faithfulness to His people despite the adversity they are facing?
- 3) When Stephen talks about Moses. What qualities of Moses does he emphasize and how do they relate to the overall message about Jesus?
- 4) How does the faith demonstrated by Abraham, Joseph, and Moses serve as an example for believers today?

## PRAY

- 1) Take some time to reflect on the example of faithfulness and obedience to God from Abraham, Joseph, and Moses. Pray for God to cultivate similar faith and obedience in your own lives.
- 2) Pray for opportunities to bear witness to others about Jesus. Pray that you would recognize Him as the ultimate fulfillment of God's promises and the true deliverer of all.
- 3) Pray for the Gospel to transform lives at Austin Ridge and our community, just as we see in the early church.
