CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

Describe a circumstance in your life that made it difficult to trust God's sovereignty, but you ultimately felt His faithfulness?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message? What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1) Reflecting on Abraham's journey, how can we remain faithful to God's promises even when we face uncertainty in our own lives?
- 2) In what ways can we apply Joseph's example of forgiveness and reconciliation in our relationships with others, especially when we are left feeling betrayed?
- 3) How does the faith demonstrated by Abraham, Joseph, and Moses serve as an example for believers today? How does your life exhibit that type of faith?
- 4) In what ways can we boldly proclaim the truth of God's word and testify to His ultimate faithfulness in our communities, work, and areas of influence?

PRAY

- Take some time to reflect on the example of faithfulness and obedience to God from Abraham, Joseph, and Moses.
 Pray for God to cultivate similar faith and obedience in your own lives.
- Pray for opportunities to bear witness to others about Jesus. Pray that we recognize Him as the ultimate fulfillment of God's promises and the true deliverer to all.
- 3) Pray for the Gospel to transform lives at Austin Ridge and our community, just as we see in the early church.
