SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: ACTS 4:13-22 SERMON DATE: 1.28.24

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

Have you ever been around someone who exuded Jesus in such a way that you wanted to be like them? Describe what they were like and how they made you feel.

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1. Peter and John display such courage and confidence in Christ. How can we grow in these areas in our relationship with Jesus?
- 2. In verse 19, Peter tells the religious leaders that they must speak about what they have seen and heard from the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. Are we compelled to share what we have seen Jesus do in our lives? What holds us back?
- 3. In verse 21, the people praise God for the miracle in the disabled man's life. Do we stop and thank God for answered prayers or miracles, or move on to the next request? How can we be more intentional to stop and praise God for His work?

PRAY

- 1. Pray for God to give us the courage to live out our faith in Him boldly, and that would overflow into the lives of others.
- 2. Take time in your group to praise God for answered prayer or miracles.
