

SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: Acts 8:4-25

SERMON DATE: April 21, 2024

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

When you were a kid, who was one of your heroes? Why did you look up to them?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

1. Read Acts 8:5-11. What do Philip and Simon have in common? How are they different?
2. Simon envied Philip, Peter, and John's power and abilities. Have you ever been envious of someone else's abilities or gifts? How did this affect you?
3. How are we similar to Simon in our desire to try and buy or earn what God gives us for free in the gift of salvation through Christ's person and work?

PRAY

1. If we harbor jealousy or envy, ask the Lord to reveal it. Then, let us repent of it. Ask the Lord to replace those desires with comfort and confidence in who He has made us to be.
2. Ask God to root out the desire to earn the free gift of His salvation and, by His spirit, humbly receive it daily with gratitude.
