PASSAGE: ACTS 18:12-28

SERMON DATE: Sept 29, 2024

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

What do you enjoy most about coming home after a long road trip?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

1. In Acts, Paul travels with many companions. Here, we see him traveling with Priscilla and Aquila (18:18). What is the importance of having a Christian community? Do we have people involved in our lives as we live the Christian life?
2. Priscilla and Aquila are some of Paul's ministry partners. What is the importance of ministering the gospel as a team or with a group of people? Are we doing ministry alone, or do we have people ministering alongside us?
3. Priscilla and Aquila correct Apollos' view on baptism (18:24-26). What can we learn from them in how they corrected Apollos?
4. Apollos goes to Achaia and is better equipped to make disciples (18:27-28). What is holding us back from making disciples? What areas do we need to grow in to make disciples?

PRAY

1. Ask God for deeper relationships within your Christian community.
2. Ask God to show you areas where you need more equipping and the boldness to step up and make disciples.
