PASSAGES: Luke 2:1–21: The Shepherds + Matthew 2:1–12: The Wise Men SERMON DATE: December 3, 2023

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

What is your favorite Christmas song or hymn? What makes it special to you?

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1. Luke 2:10 talks about how the good news (the gospel) produces great joy. Has there been a time when the good news became old and stale? How did you recapture the joy it first brought you?
- 2. After seeing and worshipping Jesus, the shepherds glorified and praised God for all they had heard and seen. How does our worship produce praise and give Him glory?
- 3. In Matthew 2:10–12, we see the wise men's response to Jesus. How are our reactions similar and different?

PRAY

- 1. This Christmas, pray that the gospel of Jesus will not be old news to us but good news that produces great joy in our hearts and lives.
- 2. Pray that God would give us opportunities this season to share with people what Jesus has done in our lives and invite them to church.
