

SERMON QUESTIONS

PASSAGE: Colossians 1:9-14

SERMON DATE: September 10, 2023

CONNECT

Start your time by catching up with everyone.

Have you ever had someone encourage you at just the right moment? Share about a time this happened to you and the impact it had.

GROW

Have someone read this week's passage out loud.

What stood out to you in the message?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage point us to Jesus?

What does this passage have to say about us?

GO

- 1) List the specific things Paul prays for the Colossians in verses 9–14. Sometimes, we pray for others, but how often do our prayers involve their spiritual growth? How can we pray for others to grow in Christ?
- 2) Why do we seem to lack perseverance, patience, and joy? How can we seek God to empower us to have these characteristics permeate our lives?
- 3) How often do we give thanks to God for our salvation? How would our lives change if we daily thanked Him for His saving grace given to us through Jesus?

PRAY

- 1) Pick someone in your Life Group to pray for and encourage this week. Pray Col 1:9–14 over them. For example, Pray that they may have spiritual wisdom (v.9), live a pleasing life to the Lord (v.10), and they would bear spiritual fruit (v.10). Text them during the week to let them know how you are praying for them.
- 2) This week, thank God daily for saving you. Ask Him to help you grow in His grace today and empower you to extend it to others.
