



SCRIPTURE: Matthew 9:35-38

1. **BELONG** – This section isn't filler but an intentional time to slow down and assess how people are doing in their personal and spiritual lives. Feel free to change the questions, but the point is to truly sit in this moment to allow time and space for encouraging spiritual connection.
 - A. What are some things the Lord has used to grab your attention this week?
 - B. With this conversation in mind, spend some time praying for one another.

2. **DISCOVER** – Read Matthew 9:35-38 together in your group and discuss the questions below. This section is all about discovering the Word together. Be an active listener as people respond to the text. Ask them follow-up questions. Help the group think through what they're saying and how it applies to them spiritually.
 - A. What things stand out to you in this passage?
 - B. What clear commands are given to us? What assurances?
 - C. What was talked about on Sunday that connects to this passage?
 - D. What other things from Sunday really compelled or convicted you?
 - E. How are you living out this passage? Are you?

3. **GO** – Use this to help your group reflect on and apply the passage from Missions Sunday. In addition:
 - A. Take time to talk about the different ministries and movements that were spotlighted.
 - B. Find out more about the spaces you and your group occupy each day.

4. **PRAYER** – Petition the Lord together as you close out your group time. Under the BELONG section, we focused our prayer on one another. However, this PRAYER section is to be a more outward-focused prayer time.
 - A. Pray for the ministries that were mentioned on Sunday.
 - B. Pray for those in your life that don't know Jesus.
